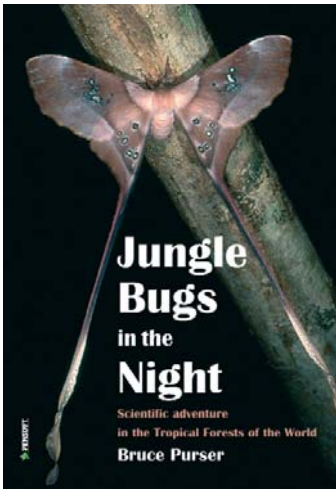

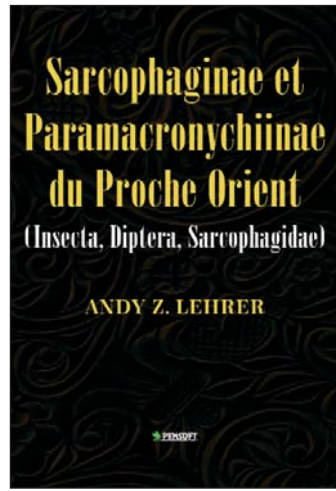

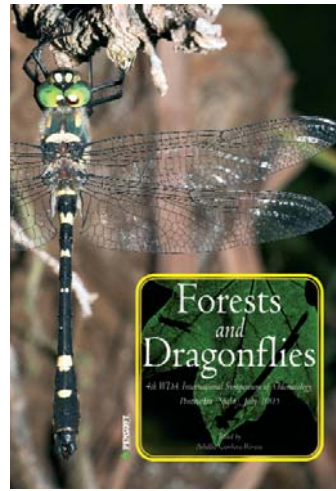

The book is addressed to specialists in moths, collectors, biogeographers and nature conservationists.



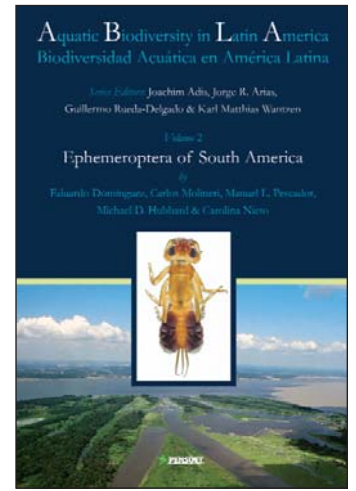
